Post-Operative Instructions for Complete Dentures

- ◆ The denture we've made for you is as durable as modern technology can make it--but no denture is indestructible. More often than not, dentures are broken when dropped while cleaning. So our first word of advice to new denture wearers--as you clean your denture, fill the sink with water or lay a washcloth down on the counter to cushion any accidents.
- ◆ If the worst happens, don't try to fix it yourself. Many glues on the market sold for "home" denture repair can permanently damage the denture material. So please come to us for help.
- ◆ A small crack in your denture may be invisible to the eye, but won't pass inspection by your tongue. If you think you feel any cracks, call us right away. A hairline fracture may be easy to repair. Otherwise, cracks can grow until the denture completely separates.
- ◆ We want to see you for regular check-ups. In order to maintain the warranty given to you for your denture, we will need to see you every 12 months.
- ◆ Please do not hesitate to call us should any problems arise.
