### **Post-Operative Instructions for Partial Dentures**

- ◆ With your new partial, your mouth probably feels stronger than it has in a while. But remember, partials have a delicate side, too. It's a complicated design, so wires and bands can bend with rough treatment. When you clean your partial, work over a towel, so it won't break if you drop it. Handle it as an investment.
- ◆ Take special care, too, of the "clasp teeth," where food can be trapped. Use the denture brush to thoroughly clean the clasps themselves. A few more minutes of hygiene each day will keep your remaining teeth healthy for a long time.
- ◆ We will also want to see you for regular check-up to maintain your other teeth and keep your partial clean. To keep the warranty given to you for your partial, we will need to see you every 3 to 6 months for a cleaning and evaluation.
- ◆ If you develop any soreness in the next few weeks, please call us right away. We may find your partial needs fine-tuning.
